SOLOMON

Bali, all us bout to be workin' without any rest. Full moon, it don't matter if the sun is in its crest. It ain't a good time now. More slaves have died along the trail than made it. Danger, no food... It would be best if you delayed it.

There's a war comin. In a fortnight or so. North vs. south for the soul of this country. If you make it to that, then you can go.

BALI

If you had a lil' girl, Would you want her livin' like a slave? Her prospects are grave with that new man and on this field here. Knowing what they got waitin' for her, constantly in fear?

SOLOMON

It's too far to make it on your own. You're gon' need folk to help you along the way.

BALI

Aint nothin' that's too far away.

We can't leave in a fortnight, We can't wait another day. Now please, tell me what I need-

SOLOMON

It's not much, but here is what I know.
